Parents and Players of Glacier United Soccer Club:

Welcome to your new team for the 2006 Spring Season. *Attached are the registration forms for you to read carefully, complete and bring with you to your team meeting on November 10, 2005. If you cannot make this meeting, please call your coach to let them know, and mail your registration to the above address by November 10.*

1. **Registration Form** – 2 sides including insurance policy information, volunteer commitment and health history. Signature of the player is required in one location and the parent's signature is required twice. Insurance information is required.
2. **Glacier United Player/Parent Contract** to be signed after reading the attached documents. **Parent Responsibility and Commitment Form** and the **Player Responsibility and Commitment Form** and the **Drug, Alcohol and Travel Policy**.
3. A check made out to **Glacier United in the amount of \$195**. Scholarships and payment plans are available and a letter explaining your need may be submitted with registration materials. The board at the December meeting will consider requests for a scholarships or a payment plan.
4. **1"x1" photo** of the players face for the player pass.
5. **Photocopy of a certified birth certificate** for players who did not play for Glacier United last spring season.

Please note the following 4 policies:

1. Glacier United players, who are in high school, may not participate in a spring season school sport. Track, tennis and other school sports conflict with Glacier United practices and games. Players who plan to take drivers education classes should refrain from taking the spring session as this class conflicts with Glacier United practices. Other possible conflicts should be discussed with the coach as soon as they are known.
2. This \$195 registration fee is non-refundable unless the player has a medical release (injury or illness) when the season begins that would keep them from playing at all during the season OR the player moves out of the Flathead Valley. Once uniforms have been ordered and fees have been paid to the state association, those costs will be deducted from the above refund. As of March 1st there will be no refunds for any reason.
3. Teams will not be registered with the state in March and will be disbanded if parents do not fulfill the required volunteer positions (1 team manager, and at least 2 certified referees)
4. When Glacier United jerseys are distributed in the spring, there will be a \$50 deposit required. This season each player will receive 2 jerseys, the Glacier Blue jersey and an alternate white jersey (U11/12 receive only 1 blue jersey). Both must be returned in good condition for the \$50 dollar deposit to be returned.

Please work through your coach or team manager with questions and issues wherever possible. If they are not available, please feel free to contact us.
